A Proclamation

Whereas, literacy is a necessary skill for Hart County citizens who wish to participate fully in society.

Whereas, parents of Hart County students need help in developing literacy skills and in becoming aware of the services available to them.

Whereas, **Hart County Literacy Day**, coupled with the Hart County Literacy Event on April 27, 2017, will provide an opportunity to encourage the citizens of Hart County to increase literacy in their homes, and to be aware of the resources available which improve reading skills.
